B'rachot for the Torah

B'rachah before the Reading of the Torah

You start by reciting:

Bar'chu et Adonai ha-m'vorach.

Praise Adonai, source of all blessing.

The congregation responds and then you repeat this line:

Baruch Adonai ha-m'vorach l'olam va'ed.

Praised be Adonai, source of all blessing forever and ever.

You continue with the b'rachah:

Baruch ata Adonai Eloheinu melech ha'olam asher bachar banu mikol...

You are praised Adonai our God, ruler of the universe, who chose us from all...

...ha-amim v'natan lanu et Torato. Baruch ata Adonai notein ha-Torah ...peoples to give us Your Torah. You are praised Adonai, giver of the Torah.

B'rachah after the Reading of the Torah

Baruch ata Adonai Eloheinu melech ha'olam asher natan lanu Torat emet...

You are praised Adonai our God, ruler of the universe, who gave us a Torah of truth...

...v'chayei olam nata b'tocheinu. Baruch ata Adonai notein ha-Torah.

...and planted within us eternal life. You are praised Adonai, giver of the Torah
