## What you need to know when a death occurs

## Summary of what you will need to do:

- 1. Notify the Synagogue Office on 020 7794 3949. If the Synagogue Office is closed, follow the instructions on the answer machine.
- 2. Follow the instructions of the coroner or other authorities if a post mortem or autopsy needs to be carried out.
- 3. Obtain a Death Certificate from the doctor or hospital stating the cause of death.
- 4. Make an appointment with the Registrar for Births, Deaths and Marriages and take the Death Certificate and any other information requested by the Registrar. You must obtain a "Green Form" before a funeral can take place.
- 5. Arrange the date and time of the funeral with the Synagogue Office.
- 6. Notify your family and friends
- 7. Speak to the Rabbi or officiant about the eulogy and other aspects of the funeral as well as *shiva* arrangements.
