A film about Bronislaw Huberman's creation of the symphony orchestra that went on to become the Israel Philharmonic. We will also be interviewing Mira Ross (a member of our synagogue). Mira is the daughter of Zvi Haftel, who left Vienna in 1936 alongside Huberman and became the beating heart of the developing IPO as leader, manager, fixer, fundraiser and nursemaid. It was Zvi who brought them Zubin Mehta and many of the other international stars. Mira features briefly as a small child in the film.
